Ban on assembly in Belgium

To reduce the spread of the coronavirus, there is a ban on assembly in Belgium. All gatherings of more than 2 people that are not members of the same (nuclear) family are forbidden. This measure is meant to save lives. We do not know how long the ban on assembly will last.



! If you do not follow the measure, you will be sanctioned by the reception centre. The police will give you a fine.

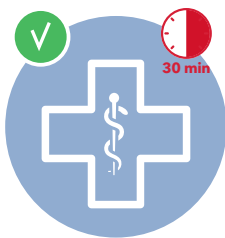
FOLLOW THE RULES:



Stay as much as possible in the reception centre /at home.



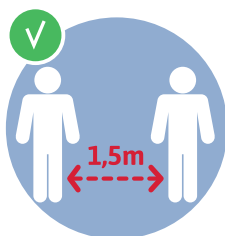
Avoid all contact with other people outside your family. Gatherings and assemblies are forbidden.



Only essential movements are allowed (buy food, go to pharmacy).



Outdoor activities (walking, cycling) are allowed, in company of your family or 1 friend.



Keep a 1.5-metre distance from other people.



Nights outside the reception centre are not allowed: you stay every night in the reception centre or you choose to stay permanently with family or friends.



Inform your social assistant, if you choose to stay with family or friends.
