A vaccine protects successfully against coronavirus.



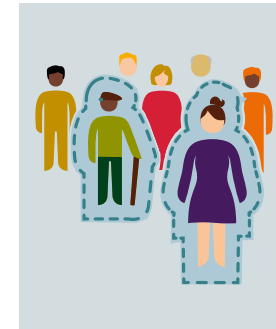
You have probably already received your coronavirus vaccine.



After a few months, the vaccine no longer works so well. That is why it is best to get an extra shot. The extra injection is called a **booster shot**.



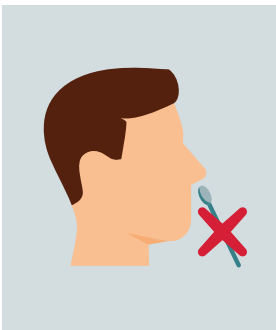
The booster shot increases your immunity and protects you from getting very ill.



If many people receive a booster shot, fewer people will become ill.



That way, there will be enough beds in the hospitals to care for all sick people.



With a booster shot, you do not have to have a coronavirus test after a high-risk contact.



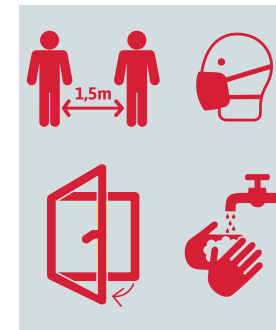
With a booster shot, you no longer have to quarantine after a high-risk contact. Be careful, though.



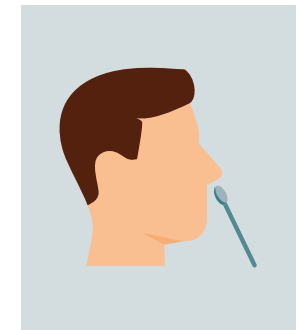
A booster shot is also recommended after a coronavirus infection to increase your immunity.



When it is your turn for a booster shot, the staff at the reception centre will inform you. Do not miss your appointment!



After your booster shot, you should still follow the rules: keep your distance, wear a face mask, ventilate the rooms and wash your hands regularly.



And get tested if you experience coronavirus symptoms.
